



## Village of Waterford - 2018

### Weekly Garbage Collection / Bi-Weekly Recycling Collection

Garbage is collected every Wednesday. Recyclables are collected every other Wednesday according to the recycling schedule. Garbage and recyclables must be placed at curbside by **6:00 am on Wednesdays**. The garbage cart should be placed within 2 ft. of the street on one side of the driveway and the recycle cart should be placed within 2 ft. of the street on the other side of the driveway. Please keep 6 ft. of clearance between the carts and other objects, especially mailboxes, poles and vehicles.

All collections will be delayed one day on the following holidays: **New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day and Christmas Day**

Additional 48 gallon or 96 gallon carts are available through Johns Disposal Service, Inc at 1-888-473-4701 for an annual fee.  
Additional Recycling container is \$42.00 annually / Additional Garbage container is \$60.00 annually. Regardless of size

***Thank you for your recycling efforts! Remember that recycling extends the useful life of our landfills. Reducing our waste through recycling is good for our environment, cuts air pollution and saves energy.***

### Mandatory Recycling

The following items can be placed in the green recycling cart: Please rinse the containers. Labels do not need to be removed.

**Mixed Containers:** Aluminum cans, clean aluminum foil, Tin cans, Steel cans, Aerosol cans, Empty/dried paint cans, Glass bottles/jars, Plastic containers marked #1-7, Milk cartons, juice boxes, soup cartons.

**Mixed Paper:** Newspaper, Magazines, Books, Mail, School/office paper, Brown corrugated cardboard, Gray chipboard (cereal & shoe boxes), Brown paper bags

**Shredded paper:** Place in a clear plastic bag and then place bag in **GREEN** recycling cart

**DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN THE RECYCLING CONTAINER:** Styrofoam of any kind, Yard waste, Trash, Household hazardous waste, Construction materials, Electronics, Clothing

### Bulk Item Collection

Johns Disposal will collect large items such as: Appliances, Electronics (including televisions), Extra cans and bags of trash, Sofa, Mattress, Chair, Rolled carpeting in 4' lengths, Lawn mower, Motor oil, Antifreeze, Car batteries, Construction debris contained in cans & bags. Call Johns to schedule a special pickup and for pricing.

### **Permit Required for Village Drop-Off Site**

The Village Drop-Off Site is located at 801 Ela Avenue in the Industrial Park. This location is for **yard waste only**. It is open from April to November; alternating Wednesdays and Saturdays **and every Saturday October through November**, from 8:00 am to Noon. These dates are indicated with a "leaf" on the reverse side of this sheet. **A Permit is required to use the drop site at an annual fee of \$20.00.** Please bring proof of residency to pick up your permit at Village Hall, 123 N. River St. Monday through Friday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. The fee for a replacement permit is \$20.00. Bags containing yard waste will NOT BE returned.

### Brush Collection/Chipping

Limbs from residential yard work are collected and chipped every other Monday the same week that recyclables are picked up, weather permitting. Limbs may be no larger than 4" in diameter and must be neatly stacked in piles, with the cut ends facing the curb. At no time can the brush piles obstruct the sidewalk. The time limit per stop cannot exceed 15 minutes. **No leaves, grass clippings or yard waste will be chipped.** These may be brought to the drop-off site. **There will be no Brush Chipping from December 1<sup>st</sup> through March 31<sup>st</sup>.**
