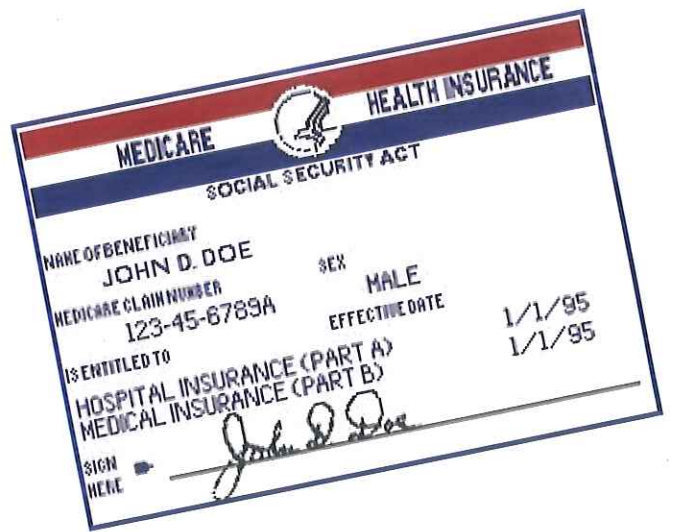


BEWARE of the NEW Medicare Card SCAM



- Beware of phone calls from someone claiming to be from Medicare or Social Security regarding a “new” Medicare card.
- Do not give out your Medicare number or any other personal information to someone you do not know.
- Call Senior Medicare Patrol toll-free if you think your Medicare or Medicaid number is being used for scams, waste or abuse.
