**INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$9,950,000**

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Waterford Union High School District, Racine and Waukesha Counties, Wisconsin that there shall be issued, pursuant to Chapter 67, Wisconsin Statutes, General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$9,950,000 for the purposes of paying the costs of remodeling, improvements, upgrades, and expansions to the District's existing school facility including classroom upgrades; safety upgrades; remodeling and expansion of family consumer science, art and agriculture labs and classrooms; upgrades to technology infrastructure; creation of a technology center; fitness center expansion; addition of outdoor storage and athletic/concession buildings; lighting upgrades; roof replacement; upgrades and replacement of heating and air conditioning components; parking lot and entrance improvements; and equipment acquisition related to said projects.
